Lt. Col. Martin is an MQ-1 Predator Instructor Pilot, Operations Supervisor, and Chief of the Pre-dator/Reaper Ops Branch, C2ISR Division, Directorate of Air and Space Operations, Air Combat Command Headquarters, Langley Air Force Base. He manages the organization, training, and equipment for all MQ-1/MQ-9 forces in the U.S. Air Force. This month, he will report to Holloman AFB to serve as Chief of Safety for the 49th Fighter Wing.

He earned his bachelor's degree in political science from Purdue University in 1994, and a master's degree in international studies from the University of Denver in 2002. He also attended Air Command and Staff College and took the Civil Air Patrol National Check Pilot Standardization Course.

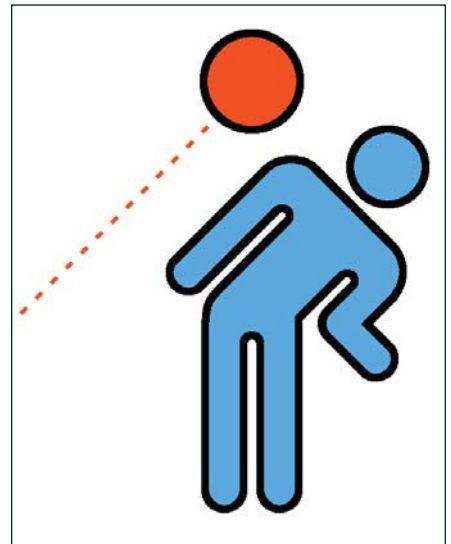
His first assignment 1994 in undergraduate space and missile training and Vandenberg AFB in California, he has steadily risen through the ranks, serving in various capacities at Air Force

bases around the country.

He is a senior navigator and RPA pilot with over 2,500 hours in T-34C, T-43A, TC-135S, RC-135U/V/W, RQ-1A, and MQ-1B, including more than 1,800 combat hours.

He also is a commercial/instrument pilot and certified flight instructor with more than 600 hours in various general aviation aircraft including the search and rescue-configured version of the Cessna 182T. He is a check pilot for the Civil Air Patrol with 70+ hours of search and rescue experience.

Lt. Col. Martin has been decorated with numerous medals and awards, including the Air Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Air Force Commendation Medal with one oak leaf cluster, Aerial Achievement Medal with five oak leaf clusters, Air Force Outstanding Unit Award with two oak leaf clusters and valor device, Air Force Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service and Expeditionary Medals, Iraqi Campaign Medal, National Defense Medal with one star, and the Air Force Training Ribbon.
