Today's Program: Del. Harvey B. Morgan

Harvey B. Morgan, first elected to the Virginia House of Delegates in 1979, represents the 98th Legislative District which includes all of Gloucester, Mathews, Middlesex and Essex Counties and portions of King and Queen and King William Counties.

A native of Gloucester, Morgan graduated from Gloucester public schools; earned a bachelor's degree from Hampden-Sydney College and a bachelor's degree in pharmacy from the Medical College of Virginia. In 2008, Virginia Commonwealth University conferred the Doctor of Humanities Honorary Degree. He served in the United States Navy, and until 1990 was co-owner with his father and brother of Morgan's Drug Stores in Gloucester and West Point.

Delegate Morgan serves as chairman of the Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources Committee and is the ranking member of the

Commerce and Labor Committee. He is Chairman of Higher Education and a member of the Health and Human Resources and the Natural Resources Subcommittees of the Appropriations Committee.

He serves on the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission (JLARC), the Joint Commission on Health Care (JCHC), is Chairman of the State Water Commission and is a member of the Rappahannock River Basin Commission and the Chesapeake Bay Restoration Fund Advisory Committee. Morgan is a member of the National Conference of State Legislators' Communications, Technology and Interstate Commerce Committee.

Delegate Morgan has received a long list of awards and honors for his leadership. He is married to the former Mary Helen Osborn and has one daughter, Gayle Morgan Vail.
