## Great Baseball At Great Price Tonight in Hampton

Please join us tonight for "An Evening at the Ballpark" with the Kiwanis Club of Williamsburg and the Peninsula Pilots, and help support the Local Food Bank! Bring a canned good item to the game and get a \$1 off your ticket price, which are already very reasonable for such great entertainment.

The Pilots will host the Edenton Steamers at 7 p.m. at War Memorial Stadium in Hampton. Tickets are general admission; if you saved your ticket you received when the Pilots spoke to us a few weeks ago, it can be free! Adults are \$5; children under 12, \$3; seniors 60 and older, \$3; active military in FREE with ID. Additional adult family members are \$3 and children under 12 are \$2.



You also can bring a picnic with a minimum of 25 people, and the \$15 per person price includes ticket to the game, exclusive use of the Pilots Patio and Tiki Bar and/or the party deck from 5:30 p.m. until game time. All-you-can-eat barbeque, baked beans, cole slaw, soda, dessert, public address announcement, visit by Pilots players and mascot Slyder, and first pitch opportunity for company representative.

Directions to War Memorial Stadium From Williamsburg/ Newport News: Take I-64 East toward Hampton/Norfolk. Take Exit #264/downtown Newport News/Suffolk onto I-664 South. Take Exit #2/Powhatan Parkway. Turn left onto Powhatan Parkway. At second stoplight take a right onto Pembroke Avenue. The stadium is about 200 yards on the left.

# Today's Topic: Virginia Shakespeare Festival

In 1753, the Hallam troupe, having broken with London's New Wells Theatre, arrived in Williamsburg to present "The Merchant of Venice," the first professional production of Shakespeare in the New World. Nearly 250 years later, the Virginia Shakespeare Festival continues the tradition of bringing Shakespeare to local audiences with its 32nd annual season.

Well-known local actor Joseph Dellinger will introduce his fellow actors, and will participate in an excerpt of "As You Like It."

She has a background in costume design, and other passions include reading, painting, and flying kites.

## *The Plays*

**"As You Like It" by William Shakespeare, July 7-July 18** – Cousins

Rosalind and Celia take off to the Forest of Arden, in search of the wrongfully banished Duke and his

group of merry men. Rosalind's disguise as a boy may help keep them safe but also will prove an interesting obstacle to wooing the handsome Orlando. One of the Bard's most beloved comedies, with songs galore and the famous "7 Ages of Man" speech to enliven the romantic escapades of not just one but four somewhat mis-matched couples.

**"A Man For All Seasons" by Robert Bolt, July 22-Aug. 1**–Winner of multiple Tony Awards on Broadway as well as three Academy Awards for the film version, this story of Sir Thomas More's opposition to the marriage of Henry VIII to Anne Boleyn finds a perfect home at the Virginia Shakespeare Festival. Both comic at times and highly dramatic, this fascinating story of one man's unflinching honor is both an uplifting evening and an acting tour de force. John Ammerman, who has starred in previous VSF productions of Macbeth, Illyria, and The Complete History of America Abridged, returns in the title role.
