Skelly serving as a substitute. I am asking for another few folks to volunteer as substitutes in case the regular team can't make it due to vacation, doctor's appointment, etc.

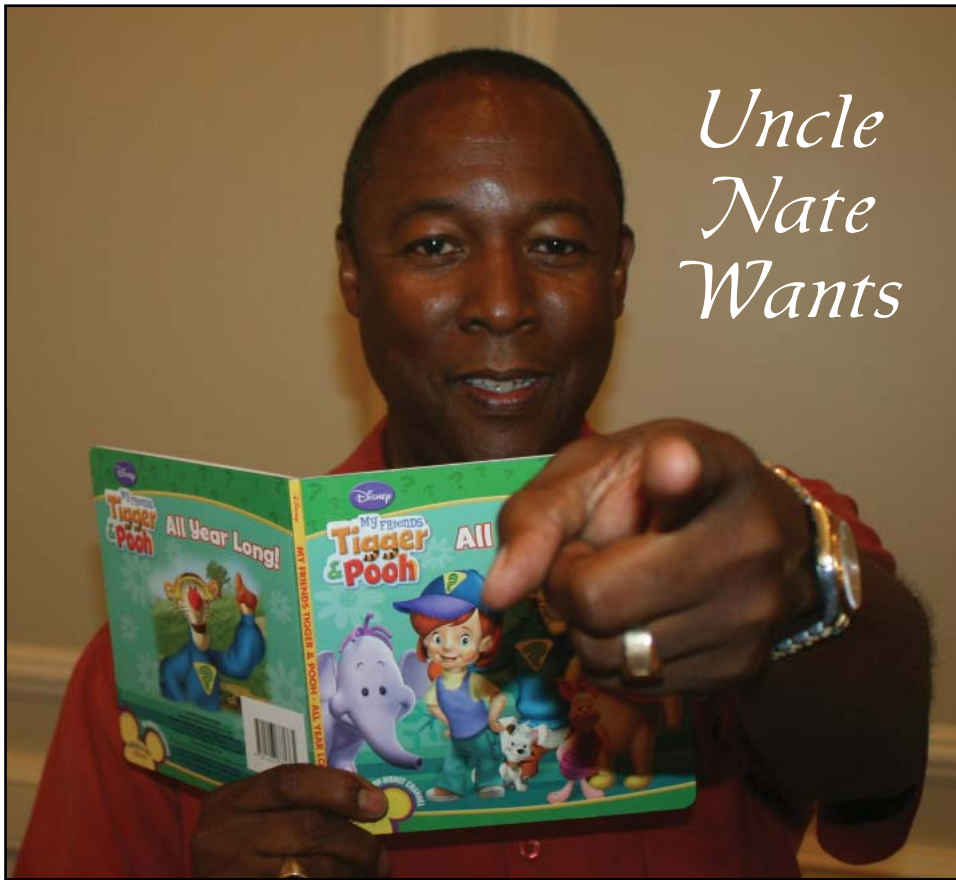
