Two Chances Coming For Us To Enjoy Virginia Symphony As A Group



There are two opportunities to hear the Virginia Symphony Orchestra as a Kiwanian group. The VSO is considered one of the finest symphonies in the country and is here in our backyard. Less than the price of a good dinner for the best seats.

The first opportunity is the Symphony's performance of the epic "Carmina Burana" with the Symphony Chorus, and the Samuel Barber Symphony No. 1 in one movement on Friday, Jan. 21, at 8 p.m. the Ferguson Center in Newport News. JoAnn Falletta will conduct. "Carmina Burana" is one of the most popular symphonic pieces that celebrates romantic love and carnal desire. Prices for this concert range from \$18 to \$59.

Our second opportunity will be on Thursday, Jan. 27, at 8 p.m. right here in Williamsburg at St. Bede Catholic Church. The Symphony will perform a Gershwin Celebration, including music

Today's Speaker: Tony Shaver

When Tony Shaver accepted the head coaching position at William and Mary in May of 2003, he set his sights on making the Tribe a winning program. Fast-forward seven years and the two-time CAA Coach of the Year and National Mid-Major Coach of the Year finalist has led a revival of the Green and Gold program.

This past season, he once again took W&M to the brink of its first-ever CAA title and NCAA Tournament appearance, while in the process leading the College to the third-most wins in school history and its second-ever postseason bid in the National Invitational Tournament. Shaver enters his eighth season with the College and 25th overall as one of the winningest active coaches in college basketball. He ranks 28th among active Division I head coach with 445 victories, while ranking 43rd in winning percentage at .645.

Along with its success on the court, Tribe players have done their work in the classroom as well under Shaver. This past season, W&M had a team grade point average of nearly 3.0 at one of the toughest academic institutions in the country.

He came to W&M after coaching 17 seasons at Hampden-Sydney, compiling a record of 358-121 (.747). He turned the Tigers into a Division III national powerhouse, leading the men's basketball team to eight Old Dominion Athletic Conference titles, 12 20-win seasons and 11 NCAA Division III Tournament appearances. In 2003, the team finished 29-3, setting a school record for most wins in a season.

Prior to taking over at Hampden-Sydney for the 1986-87 campaign, Shaver spent 10 years as the head boys' basketball coach at Episcopal High School in Alexandria. He was named the Virginia Independent Schools Athletic Association State Coach of the

Year in 1986, and was twice picked as the Alexandria Coach of the Year, while winning 73 percent of his games. In November 2005, Shaver was inducted into the Episcopal High School Hall of Fame.

A 1976 graduate of North Carolina, Shaver was a guard on the Tar Heel men's basketball team from 1972-75 under head coach Dean Smith. Originally a walk-on, he earned a scholarship his rookie season, when he was awarded the prestigious Butch Bennett Award, presented to the freshman who exemplifies determination, sportsmanship and sacrifice for the team.

A native of High Point, NC, Shaver and his wife, Ann, are the parents of three sons: Christopher, 29, Austin, 26, and Jackson, 19.
