Kristy L. Plourde is the U. S. Coast Guard's Training Program Coordinator for the National Incident Management System (NIMS) Incident Command System (ICS) Implementation.

Before coming to this position, she was on Active Duty in the Coast Guard and was the Deputy Commander of the Coast Guard National Strike Force. She also served as the Chief of Port Operations at the Coast Guard Marine Safety Office San Francisco Bay, in Alameda, CA, where she responded to numerous oil spills and hazardous chemical releases.

She has served as the U.S. Coast Guard Federal On-Scene Coordinators Representative/Incident Commander, Operations and Planning Section Chiefs, and other roles during large incident responses

including Incident Command System Advisor and Lead Trainer for Just-in-Time Training for the Deepwater Horizon Spill response, Deputy Incident Commander and Planning Section Chief for Coast Guard response to Hurricane Rita in Texas, Operations Section Chief and Deputy Incident Commander for the EPA during the Space Shuttle Columbia disaster response and as Deputy Planning Section Chief for the Coast Guard at G-8 Summit, a National Special Security Event (NSSE).

Rice Trolan, Board Member



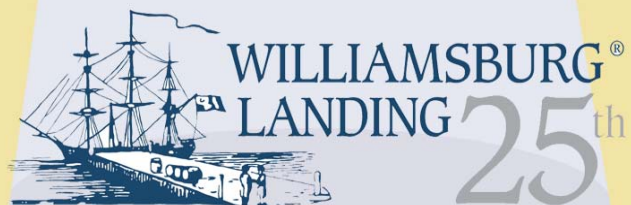
Trolan
